



- Mirador de San Nicolas. Viewpoint on an elevated hilltop, best known for dramatic sunset views.
 - Paseo de los Tristes Popular narrow street by the side of the river Darro. Nice square by the Fuente.
- Best walking route to **The Alhambra** from the City. (book visit few months in advance allow 3hrs).

- Calle de las Teterias (Tea Houses Street), a charming street renamed as the little Marrakech.
 - Barrio del Sacromonte Museums, house caves, flamenco shows, shops with unique souvenirs.
 - The Catedral de Granada which towers over the Plaza de las Pasiegas. Go La Finca for great Coffee!
 - Alcaicería is an old Islamic market (bazaar) in the historic heart of the city. Located by the Cathedral.

- 6 Heladería Los Italianos Really good. Best ice cream in Granada, probably.
